This presently runs in a pipe under the gardens of the neighbouring homes but the pipe has failed and is causing flooding. There were, in principle, no objections by TECT to this solution but ongoing maintenance is a concern. TECT had received some Elm trees which they will plant. Extra tree maintenance will not be possible because of budget limitations.</p>

1/20/15	<p><b>Update on works at Railway Bridge, Novington Lane</b>  LDC have been assured that the site will return to agriculture at the end of the contract. Residents have contacted parish councillors to complain about mud on the lane, and damage to the verges. The contractors have been cleaning the road several times each day and damage to the verges is mostly being caused by motorists refusing to wait whilst larger vehicles enter or exit the site, choosing instead to mount the verge – causing the damage.</p>
